Dr. Christopher Eagar, one of the founders of the Northeastern States Research Cooperative and Project Leader with the U.S. Forest Service Northern Research Station in Durham, New Hampshire, recently retired from his position as NSRC Program Manager.

Chris helped organize the NSRC and obtain the first year of funding for Northern Forest ecosystem research in 2001. He partnered with the University of Vermont and the University of New Hampshire to develop Themes One and Two and oversaw development of the NSRC mission across the four Northern Forest states with creation of Themes Three and Four in collaboration with the University of Maine and the State University of New York. Under his leadership, the NSRC has awarded well over 200 research grants totaling over \$15 million.

We wish Chris the best during the impending phases of his retirement and thank him for his vision early on, his hard work, and his long-time dedication to the NSRC program.
